Independent Thinkers:

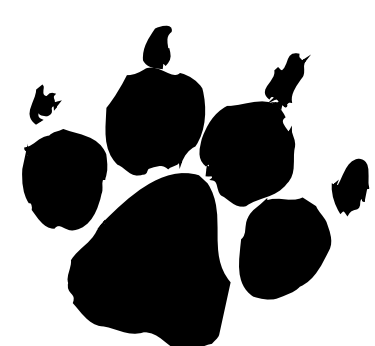
While working individually or in teams, students are able to think for themselves to bring their unique perspectives to any challenge.
