Policy Regarding Cell Phones/IPODS/Any Electronic Device

California Education Code 48901.5 – States that no students shall be in possession of any electronic device.

Shasta Union High School District Policy regarding radios/tape players/pagers/cell phones— Students are not permitted to bring radios, tape or disc players with or without earphones, cell phones or beepers to school without written permission from school administration. The school is not responsible for loss of radios, tape or disc players, beepers or cell phones brought to school.

Students are not to display any electronic device until school is dismissed at 3:15 (2:15 on minimum days). This means before school, during passing periods and at brunch and lunch.

First Offense—Electronic device will be confiscated and given to the secretary in the office. Parents will be required to *come in to the office* before 4:00 Monday – Friday to sign the Cell Phones/IPODS/Any Electronic Device Policy and claim the item.

Second Offense—Electronic device will be confiscated and given to the secretary in the office. Parents will be required to *come in to the office* before 4:00 Monday – Friday to sign the Cell Phones/IPODS/Any Electronic Device Policy and claim the item. The student will be assigned a Saturday school.

Third (or more) Offense—Electronic device will be confiscated and given to the secretary in the office. Parents will be required to *come in to the office* before 4:00 Monday – Friday to sign the Cell Phones/IPODS/Any Electronic Device Policy and claim the item. The student will be given an in-school suspension for one to five days.

Violations do not “zero out” and start over each school year. If a student has one or more violations at the end of the school year, their first violation the following school year will be considered a second offense and result in an automatic Saturday school.
