- The Foothill girl's softball team beat Red Bluff High School 9-3 Saturday for their 2nd straight Division III Championship. Star pitcher Jessica Seely seemed to be cruising to another one of her pitching gems as she shut out RBHS through the first three innings but she injured her knee in the bottom of the third inning, and Sunshine Wehunt was the next one up. Foothill rallied around Wehunt in the pitcher's circle, out-dueling the Spartans. Wehunt pitched a scoreless fourth and fifth inning, and protected Foothill's early 3-0 lead. The win also capped a remarkable four-year run for this year's Foothill senior class. FHS's cumulative record over four seasons is 114-23-1 with two section titles and three league championships. First place finishes for JV include: Tyler Steppat pole vault, Claire Durbin girls 800 & 100 meters, Travis Lee boys 300 hurdles, Isaiah Putnam boys high jump, Caleb Rowe boys triple jump, Melody Wu girls 100 & 200 meters, Lucy Thompson girls shot put, Grace Palumbo girls high jump, boys 4 x 400 relay team & girls 4 x 100 & 4 x 400 relay teams. Meets also were held Friday in Divisions II, III and IV. Event winners will go on to compete in Friday's Northern Section finals at West Valley High School in Cottonwood. Athletes who recorded the four next-best results also will go to the section meet.
