As the year draws to a close, listed below is important information regarding the end of the year activities:

Senior Breakfast: Friday, June 2, 7:30am

- From 7:30am to 9:00 am we will be serving the annual Senior Breakfast across from the senior bench on the outdoor stage. Seniors are free of charge, while parents and guests are \$10.00 each.

Graduation Meeting: Friday, June 2, 8:30am-9:00am (Students only)

 All seniors need to meet in the Student Union for a brief graduation meeting where graduation protocols will be discussed.

Senior Awards Ceremony: Friday, June 2

 Beginning in the Student Union following the senior meeting, seniors receiving various awards and scholarships will be honored. You will be contacted prior to the ceremony by the counseling staff if your student is receiving an award; however, all seniors are welcome to attend! Seniors not attending the awards ceremony will be required to be in class. This is NOT an early release day for seniors.

Finals Week: Tuesday June 6 – Thursday June 8

 As graduation rehearsal is scheduled for the morning of Thursday, June 8, seniors will be taking their final scheduled for that day prior to practice. Graduation Practice: Thursday, June 8, 8:45am, Bill Johnson Memorial Stadium

All seniors must attend in order to participate in the graduation ceremony. We will walk
through the ceremony from start to finish to ensure all seniors know exactly what to do and
what is expected. Students must provide their own transportation at the conclusion of
practice.

Graduation: Thursday, June 8, 8:00pm, Bill Johnson Memorial Stadium

- Seating will open at 6:00pm. (Seniors are to report to the small gym at 7:00pm for preparation and line-up). Handicapped parking will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis. The lower parking lot will be available for handicapped and elderly guests. Parking will be accessible just prior to 6:00pm.
- Seniors will be required to complete the check-out process in order to get the official copy of their diploma. Check-out forms will be distributed, by counselors, earlier in the week on Monday, June 5.

Graduation Attire:

• This is a formal ceremony so students must be neatly dressed so that clothing does not distract from the ceremony. Students may wear slacks, dress jeans and collared shirts. Clean athletic shoes or dress cowboy boots will be allowed. Sunglasses or "flip flop" sandals will not be permitted. Any sashes worn must be approved by Mr. Greene ahead of time. Students will not be allowed to wear leis and caps cannot be altered in any way.
